At the PA Pittsburgh Hays nest, clutch 1 had one egg which was lost 2 days after laying when the nest tree fell; the eagles built a new nest and laid another egg 7 days after the first egg was lost; it is unknown whether they laid another egg inbetween, but the interruption of egg-laying and the 9-day interval between known eggs suggest a new clutch.

2020 -- Includes 2 clutches laid at the AZ Fish & Game, CA Sauces Canyon, and CA West End nests, and 2 broods of eaglets at the FL Southwest nest. The FL brood 2 came after the loss of the only eaglet from brood 1 (as opposed to lost eggs), a rare occurrence among Bald Eagles. Brood 2 resulted in 2 successful fledges.
