NOTES:

* 2017: At the Pittsburgh Hays nest the adults built a new nest and laid another egg 7 days after the first egg was lost; it is unknown whether they laid an egg inbetween, but the interruption of egg-laying and the 9-day interval between known eggs suggest a new clutch.

† 2020: The second clutch at the Southwest Florida nest came after the loss of the single eaglet from brood 1. Reclutching after losing a brood of eaglets is a rare occurrence among Bald Eagles.
